

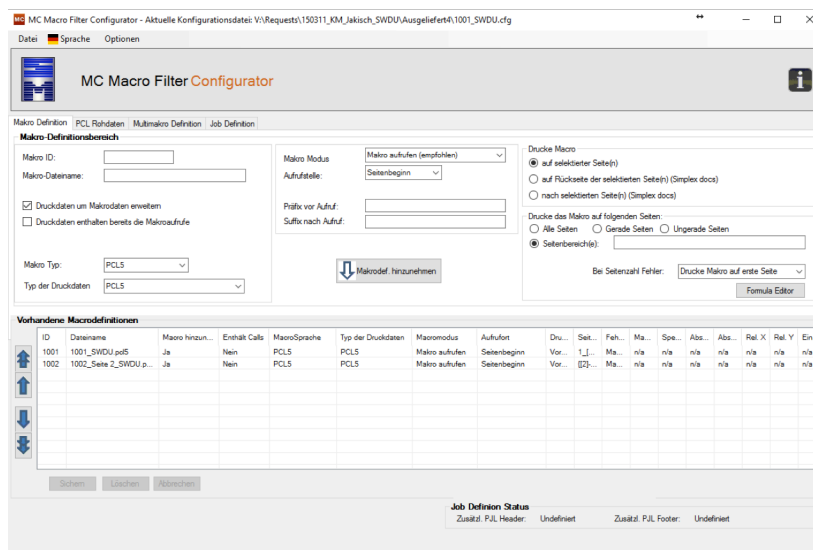


BENS Macro Configurator

BENS Macro Configurator is a free Windows program from Suchy MIPS GmbH that supports BENS users when creating configurations for the BENS Macro Filter.

The configurator determines which macros are to be placed on which pages. For this purpose page numbers, page ranges, pages intervals and terms such as "even pages", "odd pages" or "last page" can be defined. It is also possible to use mathematical formulas. For example: the last page will be defined as "N", the second last as "N-1" and so on. The Macro Configurator also allows the definition of macros, which will be printed on back sides of 1-sided documents (for example, GTC's). The Macro Filter detects such information and changes on the specified page(s) into the duplex mode, prints the macro on the back side of the page and returns to the simplex mode.

With the aid of the configuration the Macro Filter is able to insert macros in print files without the need of using special macro commands in the print file.



For documents that previously were processed by the BENS CarbonCopy Filter, there are often complex requirements for the placement of macros such as "Last page of each copy" or "From page 2 to last page of each copy". For these purposes, the configurator offers a formula editor and a large number of predefined functions
