



BENS SplitSpool Filter

The BENS SplitSpool filter separates print data from a spool file into several different print jobs. That way the possibility is given for further post-processing (e.g. stapling) single documents stored in a spool file. Example: from an ERP system invoices are edited for printing in such a way that invoices addressed to several different recipients are written into one single print job. That way it is prevented that, for example, invoices to each receiver can be stapled singly. By separating the single invoices into single print jobs stapling is again possible.

Via a filter-configuration file the filter receives a message telling how the job limits can be recognized. As it is unknown how many pages belong to a single document (e.g. an invoice addressed to a receiver), the filter has to react to incidents like a suddenly changing invoice number. The incidents to which the filter is supposed to react are determined in a configuration file.
